

Terms of Reference for Socio- Technician

Position Title	: WASH (Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene) Technician
Location	: Godawari Municipality-8, Dukuchhap
Type of Contract	: Fixed Term
Duration	: Full-time, 15 Months
Reporting to	: Field Coordinator and Team Leader

1. Background:

The WASH Technician will play a critical role in supporting the implementation of Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene projects within Centre for Integrated Urban Development (CIUD under **"Driving Innovative Piped Water Supply for Access to Safely Managed Water for Communities affected by Water Crisis in South Asia"** (Dukuchhap WASH Project). This position requires technical expertise in WASH-related activities and a proactive approach to ensuring the quality and sustainability of WASH interventions.

2. Responsibilities:

Technical Support:

- Assist in the civil construction works, pipe laying and jointing, installation of pipeline fittings and fittings of water supply systems.
- Conduct regular inspections and assessments of water sources to ensure water quality standards are met.
- Support the implementation of hygiene promotion activities, including software training sessions and awareness campaigns.

Monitoring and Supervision

- Monitor and supervision of WASH project activities and progress against established targets and indicators.
- Collect data and maintain records related to WASH infrastructure, usage, and impact.
- Participate in project evaluations and assessments to identify strengths, weaknesses, and areas for improvement.

Capacity Building:

- Train community members and local stakeholders on WASH practices, maintenance, and repair techniques.
- Support community-based WASH committees in their roles and responsibilities.
- Provide on-the-job training to local technicians and WASH staff as needed.

Coordination and Reporting:

- Coordinate closely with the Field Coordinator and other team members to ensure alignment with project objectives and timelines.
- Prepare regular progress reports, technical reports, and other documentation as required.

- Technical expertise in water supply systems, sanitation facilities, and hygiene promotion activities.
